

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

The fluid should be stored in cool conditions, keep container tightly closed in a well-ventilated area away from food and drink and direct sunlight. Keep out of the reach of children.

Spillage of small quantities can be mopped up with a tissue and disposed of in normal waste.

Highly flammable liquid and vapour.
Causes serious eye irritation.
May cause drowsiness or dizziness.

Eye contact: In case of contact with eyes, irrigate with room-temperature water or eyewash solution for several minutes, occasionally lifting eyelids. Remove any contact lenses if easy to do. Continue rinsing. Call a doctor if irritation persists.

Skin contact: Quickly remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with plenty of water. Call a doctor if irritation or other symptoms occur. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use.

Ingestion: If swallowed, rinse mouth thoroughly and give water to drink. Get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting, unless instructed by medical personnel.

Inhalation: Remove exposed person to fresh air and keep warm and at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Call a doctor for symptoms of drowsiness or dizziness, or if you feel unwell.

Marking and Registration Instructions for an Off-Road Vehicle

CONTENTS

- 2 Self-etch labels (for chassis)
- 2 large ultra-destruct labels
- 1 Medium size ultra-destruct label
- 1 Small ultra-destruct label for discreet positioning
- Ultra-destruct warning label
- 3 QR Code Labels
- UV marking fluid and applicator
- ISR Contact card

HOW DOES THE SYSTEM WORK?

The labels have been cut with a unique code and the web address of the ISR for uniquely and permanently identifying an off-road vehicle. The ultra-destruct material will break up into small pieces if an attempt is made to remove a label, making it impossible for a thief to re-use it. In addition if the labels are removed, the unique code and the web address will be visible under UV light.

MARKING

Labels will adhere to all surfaces likely to be encountered, provided the surfaces to be marked are clean and completely dry. Due to the powerful adhesive make sure you have decided where to position each label before removing from the backing paper.

Large labels



These should be placed in prominent locations.

Medium and small size label

This should be placed in discreet position which are not immediately visible.



The ultra-violet marking fluid should then be applied over the code and web address using the applicator provided. Ensure all the dots are filled. No further action is required.

Warning Label



This should be prominently positioned

QR Code Labels



The QR Code labels should be placed in various locations of your choice in areas that can easily be scanned if required. No fluid application is required.

SELF-ETCH LABELS

These should only be used on the painted metal chassis frame.

Peel the label from the backing paper by gently rolling the label away from you until the corner of the label can be held. Once removed, carefully position one end of the label and slowly but firmly rub into place. No further action is required.

REGISTRATION

It is very important that details of your off-road vehicle with your name and contact information are recorded on the ISR.

INFORMATION UPDATING

If you change address or sell your marked and registered off-road vehicle, you can report this to us online at the web address shown in the registration section.

VERIFICATION

The system provides an all-year-round, immediate verification service for information held on the ISR. This means that stealing a marked and registered off-road vehicle is very risky for thieves and makes a stolen and recovered item easy to return to its rightful owner.

Checks can also be carried out online at www.ISRcodecheck.com or the QR code on the labels can be scanned.

ISR CONTACT CARD

It is a good idea to keep the card with you, in case you need to contact the ISR urgently.

In the event of a theft, please report this online at www.ISRcodecheck.com. You will be asked for the code that is printed on the back of the card. This is the same unique code with which your off-road vehicle has been marked.
